A Message From our Executive Director...

I believe in Angels, both seen and unseen, performing miracles. Last spring, my cousin was visiting her son, his wife Haley and their 3 kids in Texas. One day she, Haley and the kids ran an errand to their church, parking in the fairly empty lot. Haley and the kids returned back to their van before my cousin. While Haley was putting the older two kids in the vehicle, the youngest, 23-month old Baby Jake, wandered, an arm's length away, to the next, vacant parking spot. An elderly man, unaware of the toddler, drove into the spot. Haley heard a small cry, turning around she saw the truck and yelled "STOP!". The front tire of the Ford 150 truck had stopped on top of little Jake, from his pelvis to the base of his neck. The driver would later say, "I heard hundreds of voices shouting 'STOP!". Within minutes, my cousin was there. As the ambulance arrived, she looked back at the church, and saw a line of dozens of church patrons, looking down and praying. Countless family and friends, prayed for the life of Baby Jake. At the hospital, the doctors discovered a 'pulverized' spleen, a fractured pelvis and a possible pulled ligament in his neck. Due to his small body, they didn't do surgery for the spleen, hoping it would repair itself. The fractured pelvis would also heal on his own and he would go home with a neck brace as a precaution. The next day the spleen bleeding had stopped and had begun to heal. As the the family was told of his injuries and positive prognosis, someone said, "There must have been Angels lifting that truck." Another said, "and Angelic voices, shouting 'STOP!" My cousin added, "and Angels here on earth. We've witness a 'miracle'!

For decades at Golden Girl, we've had Angels, changing and sometimes even saving the lives of our girls. This is especially true at Christmastime. Every year, I am contacted by past girls, telling me how they felt about Christmas as a Golden Girl. I often hear, "It was the only Christmas, I received a gift" or "Christmas there, I felt part of a family, being seen and loved." A 15-year-old girl unwrapped a doll (her first) and she still has it. Another girl remembers crying when she opened her gift, a bible AND a necklace with it. Each girl knows these gifts are given through donation from her anonymous "Christmas Angel". Most of our girls have been hit repeatedly by a metaphorical "truck". They've felt the heaviness of a large tire upon them while living in abusive homes. Our Golden Girl Family of Angels have shouted, "STOP!" to their past abuse and neglect. I've seen the Angels who have "lifted the truck" to save them. Baby Jake, now two, is Big Boy Jake, having fully recovered, a running and laughing, cherished and loved miracle. At Golden Girl, I'm blessed to witness Angels, seen and unseen, making it possible for our girls to experience the joys of childhood, especially at Christmas. We love to watch our girls giggling and happy, each one a cherished and loved miracle.
